Lunch

On STAAR testing days, students can either bring their lunch from home, or purchase a sack lunch from the cafeteria on **ALL testing days**. The cafeteria offers 2 options for the sack lunch:

- -Turkey and cheese on wheat with veggie sticks, fruit, and milk Or
- -Yogurt trio with veggie sticks, fruit, and milk

If students will be ordering from the cafeteria on test days, they will be placing their orders for **ALL testing days** in their ILA class during the week of February 27. Students cannot choose to order from the cafeteria one testing day, and bring lunch from home on another testing day. The sack lunch from the cafeteria costs \$2.40 for <u>each</u> lunch ordered, and will be charged to your student's lunch account. Please be sure your child has enough money in his/her account to cover the lunches ordered. If your child does not have enough money in the account, the alternate lunch (cheese sandwich and a 4 oz. juice) will be given to your child instead of the sack lunch.

Please talk with your student/s regarding if they will bring a lunch from home, or if you would like them to purchase the sack lunch from the cafeteria on all test days. Students will be placing their order during the week of February 27th in ILA class.

Snacks

Students will be asked to bring their own snacks for testing days. Snacks need to be something easy to eat, and non-messy. Suggestions include crackers, pretzels, animal crackers. Please do not send messy items that might get on the tests and invalidate your child's score.
